The minutes of the last meeting were read out and confirmed.

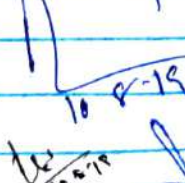
After careful discussion, the following resolutions were adopted in the meeting.

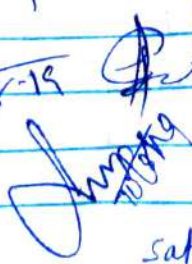
1. In view of the introduction of the Model Syllabus from the current academic session, it was suggested to aware the student regarding the latest course structure and the examination pattern.

6. It was felt necessary to conduct Swachh Bharat Programmes through out the year on regular basis.

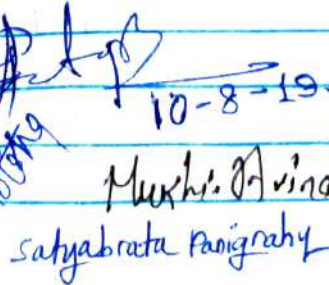
