Mr. A .R. Mohanty, IQAC Coordinator welcomed all the members and presented the action taken report. A thorough discussion was made on the following points:

- 1. Recommendations of the previous NAAC peer team.
- 2. Plan regarding the offline classes of the degree students .

The detailed plan of action, thus decided, is as follows:

- 1. As the physical classroom teaching is going to start from 11th January 2021 for the UG final year students, utmost care has to be taken for proper sanitization of the College campus, class rooms, laboratories, toilets etc. as per COVID-19 guidelines (This is because the college building was used as a RRC (Residential Reception Centre) for the migrants of this locality and also used as a TMC (Testing and Monitoring centre).
- 2. As per letter no 20119/HE dated 19th June 2020, the 2nd unit of each subject/paper(except AECC and SEC) is earmarked for student self study. Teachers will be requested to take an orientation class in the beginning to inform the students how to get access to the e-learning resources (books/PPTs/videos etc).
- 3. Subject teachers will be requested to take physical doubt clearing classes for the self study portion at least for five hours which should be planned by the concerned subject teachers and is to be reflected in the departmental time table.
- 4. The mid-semester internal assessment in all subjects/papers shall focus on the self study portion and it is to be informed to the students .
- 5. Library Automation process has to be accelerated.
- 6. A personality development workshop has to be organised.

7. The Career Counselling cell will be reformed and that cell will organise Coaching for competitive examinations for a group of 30 to 40 students which will include students from each department

especially final year students.
